As you have an arrival transfer as part of this tour, a driver will await you holding a sign with your name when you exit the airport terminal. Please note most drivers don't speak English.

Arrival Complications

Day 3 Ho Chi Minh

This morning you have a half day trip to the Cu Chi Tunnels, returning to Saigon in the afternoon. There is time for some shopping before dinner.

Day 4 Hoi An

A short flight brings you to Da Nang (approx 1 hour) before transferring to Hoi An. After arriving at the hotel, settle in time before absorbing the sights of this famous ancient city. Declared a World Heritage site, the architecture of Hoi An is being beautifully restored and preserved. It's also a shopping mecca, with much to browse over and buy. Choose from original paintings, handcrafted woodwork, ceramics, embroidery, lanterns and more. Hoi An has also become famous for its tailoring - there is a huge variety of fabrics to choose from.

Day 5 Hoi An

Free day for you to make the most of what Hoi An has to offer. Enjoy the local sea food and relax on the beaches, or explore the My Son temples on a countryside trip. You may consider doing a cooking class that your leader can organise for you.

Day 6 Hue

On arrival to the former Imperial Capital of Vietnam you have a full day to enjoy the many sights and slower pace of this tranquil city. Today you have the opportunity to visit the Imperial Citadel. Hue, known as the centre of Buddhism and education in Vietnam, has a wealth of pagodas and monasteries to discover.

You may wish to check out the bustling Dong Ba Market which offers a vast array of goods and foods to see and sample, including some traditional Hue specialties.

Day 7 Hue

You have the opportunity to visit one of the Nguyen Emperors' tombs. In the afternoon you will transfer to the train station to board the Reunification Express for the overnight journey to Hanoi.

Day 8

After arrival to Hanoi, transfer to a café for an early breakfast before driving to Ha Long Bay (approx. 3.5 hours) and board your private boat (group tour for small group numbers). You will enjoy lunch whilst cruising through some of the thousands of limestone karsts within this World Heritage site. There is an opportunity to swim in the bay's emerald waters, explore caves with incredible formations of stalactites and stalagmites and enjoy the tranquility of this bay of wonders. Spending the night on the boat allows you to sit back and enjoy the tranquility of Ha Long Bay whilst sipping away on your favorite beverage. Lunch, dinner & breakfast are included.

Day 9 Ho Chi Minh City

This morning you have the opportunity to visit Dong Trieu ceramic village as you make your way back to the capital. In Hanoi it is free time for some shopping and sightseeing before your last night dinner.

Day 10

Departure day, your transfer will pick you up from the hotel 3 hours before your departure flight.

Accommodation:

4-5 star hotels (7 nights), sleeper train (1 night), boat (1 night). Breakfast is included in all hotels where you have stayed the previous night.

Included Activities

Halong Bay boat trip includes meals & entrance fee; Imperial Citadel, Tomb x 1 in Hue; orientation tour including sight-seeing ticket in Hoi An; in HCMC, Cu Chi Tunnels, cyclo tour, War Remnants museum, day tour to Mekong Delta, including boat tour & lunch.

All transport is included for these activities.

All flights during the tour are included.

Bring along USD 100 for optional activities not included in the trip.

Tipping Guide

For your leader we recommend \$2 USD a day. For drivers & local guides, we recommend \$1 USD a day.
