**Starting Point Instructions**

As you have an arrival transfer as part of this tour, a driver will await you holding a sign with your name when you exit the airport terminal. Please note most drivers don't speak English.

**Arrival Complications**

**Day 1 Ho Chi Minh City**

Today you can check into your hotel and spend the day exploring the streets of Ho Chi Minh. Look for the Wide Eyed Tours welcome note at reception, on it your tour leader will have arranged a time to meet with you to run through the tour itinerary. After the group meeting, walk around the lake to sample some of Ho Chi Minh's best at a well known Vietnamese restaurant.

**Day 2 Ho Chi Minh City**

This morning is an early start to first go and visit the former Viet Cong stronghold at Cu Chi where the tunnel system provides a valuable insight into the tenacity and resourcefulness of the Vietnamese people. Back to HCM city, lunch followed by an orientation tour by cyclo of the main attractions. Your hotel is centrally located to the city's main shopping district and Ben Thanh Market, so there is much for you to explore and discover during the afternoon.

### Day 3 Ho Chi Minh

Today it's off to the fascinating Mekong where you get to see how life is dependant on the river for survival. Taking a boat cruise on the mighty Mekong allows for numerous photo opportunities. Another highlight is you will also get to sample an array of tropical fruits that are grown locally. Lunch included.

### Day 4 Hoi An

Today you will transfer to HCMC airport. Just over an hours flight to Da Nang before transferring to Hoi An. A short orientation walking tour followed by free time.

### Day 5 Hoi An

Free day for you to make the most of what Hoi An has to offer.

### Day 6 Hoi An

Today is a look into how food is prepared and made with a cooking demo (included) that includes a visit to the local market. The afternoon is free for you to have that last minute outfit made up!

### Day 7 Hue

On arrival to the former Imperial Capital of Vietnam you have a full day to enjoy the many sights and slower pace of this tranquil city. Today you have the opportunity to visit the Imperial Citadel. Hue, known as the centre of Buddhism and education in Vietnam, has a wealth of pagodas and monasteries to discover.

You may wish to check out the bustling Dong Ba Market which offers a vast array of goods and foods to see and sample, including some traditional Hue specialties.

### Day 8 Hue

You have the opportunity to visit one of the Nguyen Emperors' tombs plus also enjoy a boat cruise on the Perfume River. In the afternoon you will transfer to the train station to board the Reunification Express for the overnight journey to Hanoi.

### Day 9 Halong Bay

After arrival to Hanoi, transfer to a café for an early breakfast before driving to Ha Long Bay (approx. 3.5 hours) and board your private boat (group tour for small group numbers). You will enjoy lunch whilst cruising through some of the thousands of limestone karsts within this World Heritage site. There is an opportunity to swim in the bay's emerald waters, explore caves with incredible formations of stalactites and stalagmites and enjoy the tranquility of this bay of wonders. Spending the night on the boat allows you to sit back and enjoy the tranquility of Ha Long Bay whilst sipping away on your favorite beverage. Lunch, dinner & breakfast are included.

### Day 10 Hanoi

This morning involves a city tour including visiting Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum and the old French built prison followed by lunch. After lunch it is free time for any last minute shopping.

### Day 11

Today is a free day at leisure to take in all that Hanoi has to offer, your guide will be able to offer suggestions. Final night dinner!

### Day 12

Transfer to the airport for your departure flight.

#### Accommodation:

3-4 star hotels (9 nights), sleeper train (1 night), boat (1 night). Breakfast is included in all hotels where you have stayed the previous night.

#### Included Activities

Halong Bay boat trip includes meals & entrance fee; Imperial Citadel, Tomb in Hue; orientation tour in Hoi An; in HCMC, Cu Chi Tunnels, cyclo tour, day tour to Mekong Delta, including boat tour.

All transport is included for these activities. All transport included. All flights & train tickets during the tour are included. Nanny(s) included in Hoi An.

Bring along USD200 for optional activities not included in the trip.
